 ney Then my will is That my son Thomas shall not have the money due from
 Sir William Drayton as aforesaid But my deare wife shall have the same to her
 owne use And in the meane time till the death of my Father my wife shall re-
 ceive not onely the yearly Rent paid me by my Father But the interest of all
 the money I have left behind me towards the maintenance of her selfe and
 my poore Children and after my Fathers decease she shall receive the profits of
 the whole Lease all Docketon devised to my son William for her and her Chil-
 drens maintenance But see as to be accountable to my Executors for what she
 receives out and above her owne Estate I send to her if she may get it for her
 maintenance or Education of my Children which I doe begg of her by the love
 she bore me or now beares to her owne flesh and blood may be as liberal
 as her and their poore fortunes will allow And as touching my will I doe
 Charge those that take care of it to spend nothing upon it but of moneys
 lawfully And of this my last will I constitute and make Coll. Cluthome
 Silby my owne Father my Brother Thomas Silby Druggist in Chesham
 Hethplate of Bedfords in Cont Berke William Simpson of Shifford in Cont
